Summary

Work package 10 includes the coordination of dissemination, outreach and communication activities. The work is loosely categorised into communication with (i) members of the scientific community, (ii) stakeholders and (iii) the wider general public. All partners are engaged in dissemination to at least one of these groups but in many cases partners are communicating their work to a range of interested groups.

Key successes to date include a number of peer review publications in leading international journals, presentations at small, medium and large international scientific conferences and presentations to stakeholders, policy makers and government ministries. On a wider scale, several partners are engaged in programmes for the general public including media interviews, outreach programmes for school groups, town halls meetings, invited talks and material for online distribution through the FUTUREVOLC website, Facebook, and Twitter (for example, 41 news items have been tweeted under the hashtag #FUTUREVOLC or with FUTUREVOLC in the message, reaching > 50,000 Twitter users in total. This work on dissemination links closely to elements from several other work packages, particularly WP1 and communications tools therein. It is expected that the number of peer review publications will increase in the coming months as further scientific results are published.

The following three tables list peer review publications in journals, conferences and stakeholder/user groups/external partners meetings in the first 18 months of the project (reporting period 1). Deliverable 10.2 consists of this summary together with the tables below.

Preparation of peer review articles and conference presentations will of course continue throughout the project.
